The HALO (“Hope Always Lives On”) Foundation is a charitable organization located in Northeast Ohio. HALO is having its annual Wings of Charity Gala on Wednesday, September 9, 2015, from 6:00–8:30 p.m. at Guy’s Party Center, 500 East Waterloo Road, Akron, Ohio. This gala is HALO’s annual fund raiser that generates the funds needed to keep HALO operating. These funds have helped HALO develop an intergenerational volunteer program that combines the energy of youth with the wisdom of elder citizens, with a goal to teach philanthropy to our youth of today while enhancing the self-worth of the elderly. HALO is proud to say that through this collaboration, it has achieved significant milestones, including:

- Introduced the “93 cents for Flight 93” fund raising program to over 200,000 students across the nation and several other countries while partnering with the National Park Foundation, Flight 93 Memorial.
- Educated today’s youth on the principles of courage & valor displayed by the passengers and crew of Flight 93 through the creation of a graphic novel developed by students.
- Developed a week-long Leadership Retreat for youth to teach leadership skills and the role of service and responsibility to the next generation.
- Established a service model to engage youth and seniors in providing collaborative works of service. Together, they sent 3 semi-trucks and 2 vans filled with food, clothing, hygiene products and toys to survivors of hurricane disasters.
- Fundraising efforts for developing and assisting other non-profit organizations.
